  - (2) Attend Parent/Student Orientation on Saturday, June 10, 2017 – 10:30a-Noon. Bring application, payments and completed liability/health forms.
- Registration Fees:
  - (1) Teen Club Members (active 2016-2017 members only) – no application fee is due; registration is free.
  - (2) Non Teen Club Member – a \$15 registration fee is due per student at orientation.
- **TUITION: Non-Scholarship Students** - TLA will require payments per session (minimum one 2-week session must be selected for all campers). Full camp tuition will be due at the June 10, 2017 Parent/Student Orientation for at least one selected session. All other sessions must be paid *prior* to the start date for each session. **Scholarship Students** – full camp payment due at Orientation for all camp weeks. Camp weeks must be finalized at Parent/Student orientation. All registered campers will receive specific details on Parent/Student Orientation location via email. Refund Policy - There will be no refunds or partial payments for late arrivals, withdrawals or early departures including dismissal from camp due to rule violations.

### Community Scholarship (35 slots available) – Need Based Requirements:

Students applying to and eligible for the Community Scholarship must meet the requirements below. All requirements are established by The Jacksonville Children's Commission (JCC) – and are subject to change prior to registration. Student applicant must:

1. Be  $\leq$ 15 years of age (student cannot be older than 15 years of age). Middle/High school.
2. A Duval County resident.
3. **Attend the summer program for at least 5 weeks.**
4. **Bring proof/documentation required below to Orientation. No Community Scholarship applications will be accepted without documentation required below.**
5. And one of the following:
  - a. Special Education. Requires proof of:
    - i. IEP (Individual Education Plan)
    - ii. Form from the school with the child's name and current school year date
    - iii. McKay Scholarship (proof from school)
  - b. Community Eligible Student: Enrolled in one of the Duval County Public Schools that are participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs that classified as 100% Free/Reduced Lunch for 2015-2016 school year or documented by a student report card from one of those schools.
  - c. Students with Family Income at or below 185% of The Federal Poverty Level documented by:
    - i. Copy of Hero's or Step Up for Students Scholarship Letter.
    - ii. Documentation of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, WIC, and/or Medicaid or
    - iii. Verification that household family income does not exceed 185% of the Federal Poverty Level. See chart below.
